
### **★** What are Graded Readers?

Reading fluently is a skill that must be learned and practiced to quickly and confidently process text for its meaning, not just as a language exercise. Developing the skill to read fluently will not only help students to learn and use English, it will help them to do better on tests and in other real-life situations that require reading in English.

- ★ Automaticity (learning more vocabulary increasingly faster and with greater ease)

- ★ Improving independent and social work, communication, cooperation, and work skills
